The contents of the members' site of The Brewers of Europe may be used for the purposes of information, research, reference and use for the National Associations represented by The Brewers of Europe only, and not for commercial gain. You may download, view, store and print off any part of this website for your National Association or Company use only. Any other use, including the reproduction, distribution, transmission, republication, modification, display or performance of the content on this web site is strictly prohibited unless stated otherwise.

## **Website Policy**

It is the responsibility of the National Associations and Permanent Board Member Companies to establish who canget access to the members only site from within their membership.

To ensure security of the members' area we have identified a three level access as an easy and convenient solution to be given appropriately to the different members that have access to the secured area. The three level access are divided in the following manner:

Level 1: Administration access

Who: The Secretariat of The Brewers of Europe and IT maintenance.

Access: To all areas: admin area - all IMT / IWG documents - other areas

Level 2: Member access

Who: The Brewers of Europe Members (defined by National Associations and Permanent

Board Member Companies)

Access: To all IMT / IWG documents - other areas

Level 3: Non members access (consultants who are working for a National Association and/or who are part of a specific IMT)

Who: Non-members of The Brewers of Europe (e.g. members of the Beer Product IMT) Access: Only to IMT / IWG documents related to groups in which they are members

The security of the members' only area has been amplified to make sure that no other party other than the members who have individual passwords can access the website, especially through links that are sent via the e-mail alert system. This is why members do not get a direct link to the documents when they receive e-mail alerts with hyperlinks.

The system has been secured in such a way that to get access to the related documents the recipient has to connect to the website. In other words if the email alert is forwarded, the access to related documents is impossible for any individual who does not have access to the website.
